Last month, we sent out 358 survey cards to members so that we could gauge their interest in building a new traditional worship space in concept, without elaborating on the cost or design of the space. Regardless of the direction we end up taking, the amount of financial commitment from the Church Members will determine the scope of our project.

We received 102 responses (28.5%) to the survey. Of those returned, 64 (62.75%) were in favor of a new traditional worship space and 38 (37.25%) were not in favor of a new traditional worship space. It will not be possible for us to make a recommendation on anything with responses from only 28.5% of our Church. This is the third Committee over the past 15 years that has been appointed to work on this and we are counting on you to help us continue our mission of building Disciples of Christ.
